

# Argument in Favor of Measure H

Measure H is a common sense ballot measure that enhances Chino's quality of life by rezoning an inappropriate commercial property to residential.

Measure H will rezone a vacant 11-acre commercial lot east of Fern and south of Schaefer. The City's own economic study found that Chino already has a surplus of commercial sites. Measure H will provide more shoppers to support our existing Chino businesses and create additional revenue for city services.

The Chino City Council and Planning Commission BOTH voted UNANIMOUSLY in support of this Measure. Here are several reasons why local residents ask you to vote YES on Measure H:


**REDUCES TRAFFIC**—A large commercial development generates far greater traffic than a residential neighborhood. City Planning Staff estimates that Measure H will reduce future traffic at this site by 85%.

**PRESERVES NEIGHBORHOOD**—Measure H will preserve the character of the adjacent residential neighborhoods by eliminating nuisances associated with commercial development.


