

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-038

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND, ORDERING THAT A QUESTION RELATING TO ELECTING MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL BY THE VOTERS IN FIVE COUNCILMANIC DISTRICTS BE SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 4, 2014

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEREBY RESOLVES AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council has previously called and given notice of the Regular Municipal Election to be held in the City on November 4, 2014.

Section 2. The City Council, pursuant to its right and authority, does hereby order submitted to the voters at said Regular Municipal Election the following question:

Shall members of the Legislative Body of the City of Highland be elected by districts as described in Ordinance No. 393?	YES

Section 3. The text of the proposed ordinance to be submitted to the voters is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference. The Planning Commission of the City of Highland has considered the ordinance and the proposed district boundaries and made the findings required by Government Code Section 34875. The text of the proposed ordinance, including the maps and/or description of proposed district boundaries, shall be printed in the sample ballot.

Section 4. The ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and content as required by law.

Section 5. The City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

Section 6. The polls for the election shall be open at seven o'clock a.m. on the day of the election and shall remain open continuously from that time until eight o'clock p.m. of the same day when the polls shall be closed, except as provided in Section 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

Section 7. In all particulars not recited in this Resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

Section 8. Notice of the time and place of holding the election is hereby given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.


Section 9. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of Resolutions.
