**VOTE NO on MEASURE X!**

In 1996 the voters of California **DID NOT** vote to legalize marijuana, or for stores to be opened to sell pot and other marijuana based drugs. The vote simply allowed for the sales clerk to have an affirmative defense if they were arrested for possession of marijuana.

CA Attorney General Guidelines state that a primary caregiver can provide marijuana to a patient. By their definition, a caregiver is one who "has consistently assumed responsibility for the housing, health or safety of the patient." A "Sales Clerk" is not a caregiver!

**Measure X is bad** for our children and our neighborhoods because it:

- Allows Pot Shops to open 600 feet from a school or child care facility.
- Allows Pot Shops to sell marijuana-infused products like candy, cookies and brownies, which are highly attractive to children.
- Attracts crime, including shootings and robberies, and contributes to loitering and nuisance activities.
- Allows Pot Shops to open near family-oriented businesses, churches, parks and in Old Town commercial/residential.

Local law enforcement officers, educators, business owners and residents of Yucca Valley urge a **NO** vote on **Measure X** to protect neighborhoods, help keep drugs away from our children and maintain public safety.

**DO NOT** let **YV** go to **POT!**
