



RESOLUTION NO. 2015-10

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
HELENDALE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
CALLING AN ADVISORY VOTE ON NOVEMBER 3, 2015,
TO DETERMINE INTEREST IN PURSUING ENHANCED POLICE PROTECTION;
AND REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION WITH ANY AND ALL ELECTIONS TO BE
HELD IN THE SAME TERRITORY ON THAT SAME DATE

WHEREAS, the Helendale Community Services District ("the District") is a Community Services District located within the County of San Bernardino and organized and operating pursuant to California Government Code Section 61000 et seq.;

WHEREAS, the District's Board of Directors ("the Board") desires to ascertain community interest in the District initiating proceedings pursuant to the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000, commencing with Section 56000 of the California Government Code, for (1) expansion of authorized function and service to include police protection and law enforcement as defined in government Code Section 61100(i) and (2) expansion of authorized function and service to include security as defined in Government Code Section 61100(j); and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the District's Board of Directors to hold an advisory vote on November 3, 2015, for the purpose of determining community interest in the District pursuing such enhanced police protection, to request consolidation with any and all other elections to be held in the same territory on that same date, and to assist the County of San Bernardino in conducting the advisory vote and such consolidated election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Helendale Community Services District as follows:

- An advisory election shall be conducted within the District on November 3, 2015, to submit to the voters an advisory measure seeking community interest in the District pursuing enhanced police protection.
- 2. The advisory vote to be submitted to the voters shall be as follows:

Advisory Vote Only Shall the Helendale Community Services District pursue the exercise of legal authority to provide local police protection services at a cost that will	YES	
be paid by customers of, and/or property owners in, the District in amounts and in a manner to be determined later in accordance with applicable legal requirements?	NO	

- 3. The advisory vote and the results thereof shall be treated by the District's Board of Directors as only an indication of general voter opinion regarding the ballot proposal. The results of the advisory vote will in no manner be controlling on the District's Board of Directors.
- 4. The San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors is hereby requested to order that the advisory vote be held on November 3, 2015, and be consolidated with any and all elections in the same territory to be conducted that date, and that the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters conduct the advisory vote and election for the District. The District shall reimburse the County of San Bernardino for services rendered in connection with the advisory vote and election upon presentation to the District of a properly approved bill. The District shall further assist the County of San Bernardino, as needed, to prepare for and conduct the advisory vote and election within the District.
- 5. The advisory vote will be held and conducted, election officers appointed, voting precincts designated, ballots printed, polls opened and closed, ballots counted and returned, returns canvassed, results declared, certificates of election issued (if appropriate), and all of the proceedings incidental to and connected with the advisory vote shall be regulated and done in accordance with the provisions of law regulating advisory votes and elections within the District.
- 6. The Secretary of the District's Board of Directors is hereby instructed to file certified copies of this Resolution with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County and with the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters on or before 5:00 p.m. on August 7, 2015. The District's General Manager and legal counsel are authorized and instructed to take such further action as may be necessary in preparing for and conducting the advisory vote.
