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SUBJECT: **COUNTY COUNSEL ANALYSIS –CHINO VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT  
REGULAR ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2016**

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Measure \_\_\_\_\_ is submitted to the voters by the Chino Valley Unified School District ("District"). A "yes" vote by at least fifty-five percent (55%) of the voters voting on this measure will authorize the District to issue bonds to benefit the District in the amount of seven hundred fifty million dollars (\$750,000,000). If fewer than fifty-five percent (55%) of the voters voting on this measure vote yes, the Board of Education of the District will not be authorized to issue and sell the \$750,000,000 in bonds set forth in the measure.

The bond proceeds may only be used to upgrade neighborhood schools and retain/attract quality teachers by repairing deteriorating classrooms/restrooms; replace deteriorating, rusty pipes to ensure safe drinking water; remove asbestos and lead paint; upgrade fire safety, science/computer labs, wiring, classroom technology; repair, construct, and acquire educational facilities, sites, equipment.

The proceeds may not be used for any other purpose, including teacher and administrator salaries or pensions and other school operating expenses.

The District will conduct financial and performance audits annually and will appoint a citizens oversight committee to ensure that bond proceeds are spent only on the school facility projects listed in the measure.

The bonded debt will be a general obligation of the District and will be financed by property taxes levied annually on taxable property located within the District in an amount necessary to pay the annual debt obligation.
