

## Rebuttal to Argument Against Measure G

Opponents clearly didn't bother to read Measure G's official language, and to our knowledge, they haven't visited our schools or classrooms, nor have they spoken to our students or teachers.

For over a year, our District has engaged the community by holding over 150 school site meetings attended by over 2,000 parents, educators and community members, and conducting an additional community outreach process with over 3,000 residents providing feedback on school needs and community priorities in order to develop Measure G.

**FACT:** **Yes on G repairs decades-old classrooms**, including replacing the older plumbing systems and rusty, corroded water pipes found in many schools and ensuring safe drinking water, removing asbestos and lead paint, fixing restrooms, leaky roofs and updating school security and fire safety systems. Measure G addresses the urgent repairs our schools need!

**FACT:** In order for our local schools to qualify for state matching funds, our school district must have local funds. Measure G ensures that Chino Valley schools are eligible to receive money that would otherwise go to other districts.

**FACT:** Measure G requires annual performance/financial audits and Independent Citizens Oversight to ensure funds are spent as promised. By law, the Oversight Committee must include Taxpayer, Business, Senior, and Parent/PTA representatives. Absolutely NO funds can be spent for administrators' salaries or pensions.
