SUBJECT: COUNTY COUNSEL ANALYSIS –ALTA LOMA SCHOOL DISTRICT REGULAR
ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2016

Measure ____ is submitted to the voters by the Alta Loma School District ("District"). A "yes" vote by at least fifty-five percent (55%) of the voters voting on this measure will authorize the District to issue bonds to benefit the District in the amount of fifty eight million dollars (\$58,000,000). If fewer than fifty-five (55%) of the voters voting on this measure vote yes, the Board of Trustees of the District will not be authorized to issue and sell the \$58,000,000 in bonds set forth in the measure.

The bond proceeds may only be used to fund the replacement or repair of deteriorating roofs, plumbing, electrical and air conditioning systems; improvements allowing better access for students and families with disabilities; improvements to school safety and security systems; updating and modernization of classrooms to keep pace with educational technology and support student programs in science, technology, English, arts, and math.

The proceeds may not be used for any other purpose, including teacher and administrator salaries or pensions and other school operating expenses.

The District will conduct financial and performance audits annually and will appoint a citizens oversight committee to ensure that bond proceeds are spent only on the school facility projects listed in the measure.

The bonded debt will be a general obligation of the District and will be financed by property taxes levied annually on taxable property located within the District in an amount necessary to pay the annual debt obligation.
