

## Rebuttal Against Measure H

Reading the measure \$58,000,000 will be issued in a series of small bonds, each may not be over 30 years. If the last bond is issued 20 years from now with a 30 year term, we will continue to pay until 2067. The total estimated required money to pay off bonds is 110,000,000.
