NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following Measure is to be voted on by qualified voters in County Service Area 56, known as LAFCO 3202, at the Wrightwood Community Services District Special Formation Election to be held on Tuesday, March 7, 2017.

Shall the order adopted on July 20, 2016, by the Local Agency Formation Commission for San Bernardino County ordering the reorganization to include formation of the Wrightwood Community Services District and Dissolution of County Service Area 56, known as LAFCO 3202, be approved subject to the terms and conditions as more particularly described in the order?

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that this measure will pass only if approved by a majority of the district's registered voters who vote in this election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that upon approval of the formation of the Wrightwood Community Services District, this election shall also include the election of a five-member Board of Directors.

The qualifications required to be a candidate for the above office is:

A candidate must be a registered voter residing within the district at the time nomination documents are issued.

Official nomination documents for eligible candidates desiring to file for the above elective office may be obtained from the San Bernardino County Elections Office of the Registrar of Voters, 777 E. Rialto Avenue, San Bernardino, California, starting on November 14, 2016, and filed not later than 5:00 p.m. on December 9, 2016, at the San Bernardino County Elections Office of the Registrar of Voters. The San Bernardino County Elections Office is accepting nomination documents for candidates residing in either San Bernardino County or Los Angeles County.

NOTICE IS ALSO FURTHER GIVEN that 5 p.m. on December 22, 2016 is the last day and hour that arguments for or against the measure may be filed with the San Bernardino County Elections Office. Arguments shall not exceed 300 words in length and shall be accompanied by the statement set forth in Section 9600 of the Elections Code. Rebuttals shall not exceed 250 words in length and shall be accompanied by the statement set forth in Section 9600 of the Elections Code.
