**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a Special Municipal Election will be held in the City of Chino on Tuesday, July 11, 2017. The polls will open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m.

**MEASURE TO BE VOTED ON**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the following measure will be voted on at the Special Municipal Election, noticed above, to be held in the City of Chino, on Tuesday, July 11, 2017.

Measure \_\_\_\_: General Plan Amendment & Zone Change:

Shall Ordinance No. 2017-004, entitled "An Ordinance of the People of the City of Chino, California, to Enact Section No. 20.15.160 of the Chino Municipal Code Converting 29.7 Acres From the General Plan Designation of RD 1 to RD 4.5, RD 8, and RD 12 Generally Located Between Vernon Avenue and Benson Avenue, South of Adams Street, and North of the Chino Promenade Shopping Center and rezoning the same from an RD 1 designation to RD 4.5, RD 8, RD 12 designations" be adopted? **NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that pursuant to Sections 9280 through 9287 of the California Elections Code, arguments for or against the measure and rebuttal arguments shall be submitted and selected as follows:

- a. Pursuant to California Elections Code Section 9282, the City Council or any member thereof authorized by the City Council may prepare and file a written argument in favor of each of the proposed measure, not to exceed three hundred (300) words, on behalf of the City Council. In the event that an argument is filed against any of the measure, the Mayor is authorized to prepare a rebuttal argument on behalf of the City Council, which may also be signed by members of the City Council or bona fide associations or by individual voters who are eligible to vote on the measure.
- b. The last day for submission of primary arguments for or against the measure shall be 14 days from the calling of this election, which is April 18, 2017, by 5:30 p.m. pursuant to Election Code Section 9286 and shall be accompanied by Statement Form 9600 pursuant to Elections Code Section 9600.
- c. Primary arguments shall not exceed three hundred (300) words and shall be signed by not more than five persons.
- d. Pursuant to California Elections Code Section 9285, when the City Clerk has selected the arguments for and against the measure, which will be printed and distributed to the voters, the City Clerk shall send copies of the argument in favor of the measure to the authors of the argument against, and copies of the argument against to the authors of the argument in favor. Rebuttal arguments shall be printed in the same manner as the primary arguments. Each rebuttal argument shall immediately follow the primary argument that it seeks to rebut.
- e. The last day for submission of rebuttal arguments for or against the measure shall be 10 days after the final date for submission of primary arguments for or against the measure, which is April 28, 2017, by 5:30 p.m. pursuant to Election Code Section 9285 and shall be accompanied by Statement Form 9600 pursuant to Elections Code Section 9600.
- f. Rebuttal arguments shall not exceed two hundred fifty (250) words and shall be signed by not more than five persons.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that Ordinance No. 2017-004, any impartial analysis, or direct argument filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination in the Office of the City Clerk for not less than 10-calendar days from the deadline for the filing of the arguments and analysis. Any rebuttal argument filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination in the City Clerk's Office for not less than 10-calendar days from the deadline for filing rebuttal arguments.

A current copy of Chapter 20.15 of the Chino Municipal Code is on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
