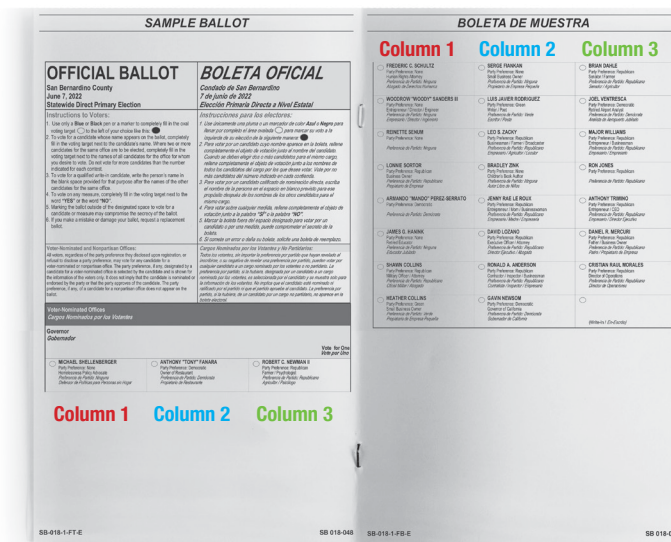
# How to Read Your County Voter Information Guide's Sample Ballot

## June 7, 2022 Statewide Direct Primary Election

In early May, registered voters in San Bernardino County received their Voter Information Guide for the June 7 Primary Election.

In the guide, voters are shown a sample ballot as a reference. Here's how it should be read.

Sample ballot pages in the Voter Information Guide are created from images of official ballot cards and may span two pages in the Voter Information Guide.



To read your sample ballot, note the continuation of each of the three columns from the bottom of the left page to the top of the right page, represented with colored labels in the diagram above.
