Observation Schedule November 6, 2012 Presidential General Election

All ballot processing for the November 6, 2012 Presidential General Election will take place at the San Bernardino County Elections Office of the Registrar of Voters according to the following schedules:

- **October 5, 2012** – The random precinct and batch selection for one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners takes place at 4 p.m.
- **October 17, 2012** – Comparison of signatures on the Mail Ballot return envelopes to those on the affidavits of registration begins at 8 a.m. and is performed daily, Monday through Saturday, until the daily workload is complete.
- **October 26, 2012** – Processing and counting of Mail Ballots begins at 8 a.m. and continues periodically Monday through Saturday until the daily workload is complete.
- **November 6, 2012** – Counting of polling place ballots begins shortly after the polls close at 8 p.m. and continues until complete.
- **November 7, 2012** – The official canvass of the election begins at 8 a.m. and continues until Tuesday, December 4, 2012 or until complete.
- **November 13, 2012** – The one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners begins at 9 a.m.
- **November 15, 2012** – The 100 percent manual tally of all votes cast on touchscreen voting units during the early voting period and on Election Day begins at 9 a.m.
