Deadline to run for office is Friday, Aug. 10 for November election

Citizens interested in running for a school or special district office have until Friday, August 10 to file candidacy documents with the County Registrar of Voters for the November 2018 Statewide General Election. Citizens interested in running for city offices up for election must pick up and file their candidate filing documents at the appropriate City Clerk's office during regular business hours.

There are approximately 240 local school and special district offices up for election in San Bernardino County.

In addition to the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters office, citizens may obtain candidacy documents for the following special district offices from the district's secretary, during regular business hours:

Candidacy documents for school or special district offices must be completed and filed at the Registrar of Voters, 777 E. Rialto Ave., San Bernardino, by 5 p.m. on Friday, Aug. 10, 2018. The Registrar of Voters will be open this week from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day through Friday.

Appointments are highly recommended, but not required. To schedule an appointment, call (909) 387-8300.

If an incumbent in any of the school or special district office does not file completed candidate documents by 5 p.m. Friday, the candidate filing period for that office will be extended to 5 p.m. on Wednesday, Aug. 15, for new candidates. Incumbents cannot file during an extended candidate filing period. The Registrar of Voters office will notify the public as to which school and special district offices candidate filing deadlines will be extended.
