## Nov. 6 Statewide General Election Day reminder



The San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters reminds voters that the Statewide General Election will be held on Tuesday, Nov. 6. There are about 940,000 voters in San Bernardino County eligible to vote in this election.



The polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Election Day. Voters can find their assigned polling place:

- On the back cover of their Voter Information Guide
- Online at SBCountyElections.com
- By calling the Registrar of Voters at (800) 881-VOTE (8683) or (909) 387-8300

Mail ballot voters who have not yet returned their voted mail ballots can still return them via the U.S. Post Office, as long as the ballots are postmarked on or before Election Day, Nov. 6, 2018, and received no later than three business days after the election in order for their ballot to be counted.

Alternatively, voters can deliver their voted ballot to any one of 57 mail ballot drop off locations, to one of the six early vote sites, or to any of the 402 polling places on Election Day. Five early vote sites will also have mail ballot drive-thru drop-offs on Election Day so voters can deliver their ballots without having to get out of their cars. All mail ballot drop-off locations, early voting sites, and polling places can be found on Registrar of Voters website <a href="mailto:SBCountyElections.com">SBCountyElections.com</a>.

Citizens who missed the Oct. 22 voter registration deadline still have an opportunity to register and vote in this election. A conditional voter registration application must be submitted in person on or before Election Day at the Registrar of Voters or at one of the five other early vote sites. After completing a voter registration application, the voter will be provided with a provisional ballot to vote at that location.

All six of the early vote sites will be open on Saturday, Nov. 3. Visit <u>SBCountyElections.com</u> to view a complete list of these locations, addresses, and hours.
