Ballots mailed to voters in the Twentynine Palms Water District



Mail ballots and Voter Information Guides will be delivered to the U.S. Postal Service on Monday, July 29 for mailing to all registered voters in the Twentynine Palms Water District for the 2019 Consolidated Mail Ballot Election.

Three candidates are vying for two seats up for election on the Twentynine Palms Water District Board of Directors.

Voted mail ballots may be returned:

- By mail so long as it's postmarked on or before Election Day, Aug. 27, and received no later than three business days after the election,
- To any mail ballot drop-off location during regular business hours on or before Election Day, or
- To the Registrar of Voters on or before 8 p.m. on Election Day.

To find a mail ballot drop-off location, voters can use the Mail Ballot Drop-Off Map quick link located on the Registrar of Voters website at SBCountyElections.com.

Any voter who does not receive, misplaces, or damages the mailed ballot may request a replacement ballot by phone – (909) 387-8300 – or email – mailballots@sbcountyelections.com – on or before Aug. 20.

A replacement ballot may also be requested and voted in person at the Registrar of Voters office, 777 E. Rialto Avenue in San Bernardino, beginning July 29, Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and on Election Day, from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Residents of the Water District who wish to register to vote and participate in this election may do so online, by mail, or in person until Aug. 12. They can click on the Voter Registration menu tab on the Registrar of Voters website to access a voter registration affidavit. From Aug. 13 through Election Day, residents must conditionally register at the Registrar of Voters office.

Voters may access personalized election information, including their Voter Information Guide and mail ballot status, using the My Elections Gateway application by visiting the Registrar of Voters website, at SBCountyElections.com.
