County Randomized Alphabet Drawing

Presidential Primary Election – March 3, 2020

In accordance with California Elections Code section 13111 (e) and (i), the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters conducted a drawing of the letters of the alphabet on December 12, 2019, to determine the randomized alphabet for use in the 2020 Presidential Primary Election, for the following State Senate and State Assembly contests:

- State Senate Districts 21, 23, 25, and 29
- State Assembly Districts 36, 41, 42, 52, and 55

Listed below is the official order of letters for use in determining placement of candidates' names on the ballot:

1. B	8. I	15. L	22. M
2. E	9. C	16. O	23. U
3. S	10. P	17. W	24. J
4. D	11. T	18. G	25. Z
5. F	12. V	19. A	26. X
6. R	13. K	20. Y	
7. H	14. Q	21. N	

Please note that this alphabet is to be applied throughout the candidate's entire last name, so if more than one candidate's surname begins with the same letter, the second letter of the surname determines who goes first, according to where the second letter of the name appears in the random alphabet. For example, if two candidates with the surname of Campbell and Carlson are running for the same office, their order on the ballot will depend on the order in which the letters "M" and "R" were drawn in the randomized alphabet drawing.
