Observation Schedule August 31, 2021 Consolidated Mail Ballot Election

The public is invited to observe as the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters conducts a series of public events related to the election. All events will take place at the Registrar of Voters according to the following schedule:

- August 2, 2021 The processing of mail ballot return envelopes begins at 8 a.m. and is performed daily, Monday through Friday, until the daily workload is complete.
- August 31, 2021 The counting of mail ballots begins at 3:30 p.m. and continues periodically, until the daily workload is complete.
- September 1, 2021 The official canvass begins at 8 a.m. and will be completed on or before September 30, 2021.

Visitors entering the Registrar of Voters Office without a mask are self-attesting that they have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19.* If you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms, please do not visit the Registrar of Voters until you feel better.
