FIVE ADDITIONAL EARLY VOTE SITES OPEN FOR 2021 CALIFORNIA GUBERNATORIAL RECALL ELECTION

The San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters has opened five additional Early Vote Sites in Apple Valley, Joshua Tree, Ontario, San Bernardino and Victorville to enable registered voters to cast their ballot in-person prior to Election Day on September 14.

All five locations are open today through Saturday, September 11, and Monday, September 13, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. They are closed on Election Day.

The locations and their addresses for the Early Vote Sites are:

Besides these five locations, registered voters can continue to go to the Registrar's office located at 777 E. Rialto Ave. in San Bernardino, which is open today through Saturday, September 11, and Monday, September 13, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. It is open on Election Day with expanded hours from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

"Early Vote Sites are ideal for registered voters who want to cast their mail ballot in person and avoid the lines of voters that may occur at the polling places on Election Day," said Bob Page, San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters.
