> Fire guts home in Hesperia, several cats rescued

Fire guts home in Hesperia, several cats rescued

Firefighters rescued several cats as they extinguished a fire that gutted a Hesperia home on Saturday afternoon.

The fire was first reported just before 1:20 p.m. in the 14000 block of Primrose Place, according to the **San Bernardino County Fire** Department.

The first firefighters on scene encountered smoke pouring from the single-story home, fire officials said. In particular, the fire was concentrated in an attached garage.

Firefighters began an "offensive fire attack" and discovered "a contents fire that quickly spread to a significant portion of the interior space within the building," the fire department said in a written statement.

They cut holes in the roof for ventilation and managed to keep the fire contained to the garage, fire officials said.

Several cats were found inside the home and removed to safety, officials said. No injuries were reported.

The cause of the fire remained under investigation. Firefighters from the Victorville Fire Department assisted their San Bernardino County Fire Department counterparts in fighting the fire.
