Fire engine is struck by vehicle at accident scene

A fire engine was struck by a vehicle at an accident scene in Upland, but no persons were injured, according to the **San Bernardino County Fire Department**.

On Jan. 26, ME12 (San Antonio Heights) was working a traffic accident at the intersection of North Euclid and 21st Street, said Public Information Officer Mike McClintock.

ME12 was positioned to block the scene, ensuring the location was safe for first responders while they provided care. But during the incident, an additional traffic collision occurred, ultimately striking ME12. Fortunately, a nearby fire captain and police officer at the scene were able to quickly dodge the vehicle and weren't struck by the new collision, McClintock said.

Crews quickly assessed the new accident for victims, finding all parties from the new accident were uninjured. ME12 received minor damage, but was successful in providing a barrier for first responders, McClintock said.

Both collisions are being investigated by the Upland Police Department.

Copter rescues injured horseback rider

Sheriff's helicopters rescue injured horseback rider who fell while riding a horse in the Black Rock Canyon on Saturday, Jan. 23, in the Yucca Valley area on Saturday.

Personnel with the **San Bernardino County Fire** Department requested the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Aviation Unit to help locate Roberta Totten, 56, who needed medical assistance. Her injuries were unknown at the time.

Deputies from the Yucca Valley Sheriff Station responded to assist. Sheriff's Rescue Helicopter, Air Rescue 306, also responded to the area to assist with locating Totten.

Air Rescue 306 conducted an extensive area check for Totten and located her with the assistance of personnel with the **San Bernardino County Fire** Department. The crew of Air Rescue 306 found the woman and hoisted her into the helicopter, which took her to Desert Regional Medical Center in Palm Springs for treatment.

Three traffic collisions were reported in Fontana on the afternoon of Jan. 26. Fontana Public Information Officer Daniel Romero provided this information about the three unrelated incidents:

- At about 12:44 p.m., officers responded to an injury traffic collision report between a white BMW, a red Ford Focus, a silver Chevy Malibu, and a black Honda Accord. A pregnant woman in one of the vehicles was treated at the scene by **San Bernardino County Fire/Medics** and transported to an area hospital as a precaution.
- At about 1:58 p.m., officers responded to a collision at Alder and Randall avenues. This crash involved a green Subaru and a gray Toyota Camry. One of the drivers complained of head pain but did not want paramedics.
- At about 2:23 p.m., officers responded to Miller and Juniper avenues for a report of a vehicle vs. pedestrian collision. A witness said a gray Toyota Camry hit a juvenile on a skateboard. The juvenile was treated by the **San Bernardino County Fire/Medics** and transported to an area hospital as a precaution. The incident was found to be an accident. No persons were cited, and drugs or alcohol were not factors in this crash.
