## Two Displaced by Yucca Valley Residential Fire

## **Summary:**

Sunday night at 10:59 PM San Bernardino County Fire crews were dispatched to a reported residential structure fire in the 7600 block of Acoma Trail, Yucca Valley. Multiple 911 callers stated smoke and fire from a home.

ME41 quickly arrived to find heavy smoke and fire showing from a single story, single family residence. Firefighters initiated a fire attack, working to keep the fire from spreading further through the home. Heavy winds fueled the fire, carrying smoke and embers to adjacent properties, threatening them. Arriving firefighters fought the fire both inside and on the roof, knocking the fire down in approximately 20 minutes. Two residents were outside prior to our arrival. Unfortunately 3 deceased cats were found inside the home. A SBCOFD Fire Investigator responded to complete a cause/origin investigation. The fire remains under investigation. Thankfully no injuries to the residents or firefighters were sustained in the incident. Red Cross was notified to assist with temporary housing and other assistance for the two displaced occupants.

San Bernardino County Fire responded with three Engines, a Medic Ambulance, Battalion Chief and Fire Investigator. CALFIRE E3554 based out of Yucca Valley assisted as well.
