

Man from Hesperia dies from getting hit by car

On Sunday, November 06, 2022, at about 10:00 pm, deputies from the Hesperia Station and emergency personnel from the **San Bernardino County Fire** Department got a call to a car crash involving a pedestrian and a 2017 Nissan Altima, in the area of Cottonwood Avenue and Juniper Street, in Hesperia.

While investigating, it is believed the Andrew Lopez walked north, along the north lane of Cottonwood Avenue and the Nissan traveled north on Cottonwood Avenue. Lopez was hit by the Nissan in the north lane of Cottonwood Avenue. As a result of the crash, Lopez died due to his injuries at the scene.

Investigators from the Hesperia Station Major Accident Investigation Team (MAIT) responded and assumed the investigation. It is still under investigation whether or not drugs and/or alcohol were a factor in this crash. Anyone who may have witnessed the collision is urged to contact Deputy D. Holland or Deputy I.
