Detached Garage Burns in City of Hesperia

Summary: On July 6th, San Bernardino County Fire received multiple reports of a structure fire at the 15K block of Fir Street in the City of Hesperia. A first alarm response was dispatched with the first unit arriving in approximately sixteen minutes. Medic Truck 304 and squad 304 arrived to find a fully involved garage to the rear of a single story home. Prior to arrival the fire had already extended to a nearby boat, vehicle as well as trees and a wooden fence on the adjacent property.

Firefighters deployed hose lines to the rear of the property with initial priorities to contain the fire to the building of origin, protect the nearby home, and limit the spread of fire that was involved with the nearby trees and brush. Once sufficient resources arrived hoselines were quickly place into service and successfully kept the fire from extending to the home on the property. The fire was ultimately knocked down in approximately 25 minutes.

San Bernardino County Fire responded with four medic engines, one medic squad, one medic ambulance, one truck, and one chief officer for a total of 20 personnel. The City of Victorville assisted with one engine but was cancelled upon arrival. No injuries were reported to firefighters or civilians. Fire investigators were requested to the scene. The fire remains under investigation..
