Fire Damages Vacant Home in 29 Palms

Date/Time: 7/30/21, 6:21 AM

Location: 6000 block of Mission, 29 Palms

Incident: Structure Fire

Summary: Yesterday San Bernardino County Fire crews were dispatched to a reported structure fire in the area of Mission and Twentynine Palms Highway. 911 callers stated a home on fire near a hotel.

ME44 arrived to find a vacant single story home well involved in fire. Firefighters initiated a transitional attack, working to knock back the fire until additional crews arrived. Once additional firefighters arrived, crews completed a primary search of the home for any potential victims. Despite the home being vacant, neighbors had observed people living in the home. The fire was ultimately knocked down in approximately 20 minutes. The fire was held to the building of origin, which sustained heavy damage. A #SBCoFD fire investigator was requested to complete a cause & origin investigation. No injuries to firefighters or citizens were reported.

San Bernardino County Fire responded with three Engines, a Battalion Chief & Fire Investigator. Combat Center Fire assisted with a Truck Company.
