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RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES) Nonfarm employment down 37,500 over the month; down 106,300 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 8.6 percent in January 2021, down from a revised 8.7 percent in December 2020, and above the year-ago estimate of 4.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 9.2 percent for California and 6.8 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 8.6 percent in Riverside County, and 8.6 percent in San Bernardino County.

<u>NOTE</u>: Labor Force and Industry data contained in this release differ from previous information due to the U.S. Department of Labor's annual revision process.

Between December 2020 and January 2021, nonfarm employment decreased by 37,500, from 1,513,200 to 1,475,700. Agricultural employment decreased by 100 jobs.


- Trade, transportation, and utilities recorded losses totaling 16,600 jobs. The reduction affected transportation, warehousing, and utilities (down 9,400 jobs), retail trade (down 6,200 jobs), and wholesale trade (down 1,000 jobs).
- Nine other sectors posted losses over the month, the shortfalls came from leisure and hospitality (down 7,400 jobs), professional and business services (down 3,700 jobs), construction (down 2,600 jobs), manufacturing (down 2,500 jobs), educational and health services (down 1,900 jobs), government (down 1,100 jobs), financial activities (down 1,000 jobs), other services (down 700 jobs), and information (down 100 jobs).
- Mining and logging registered a month-over payroll expansion of 100 jobs.

Between January 2020 and January 2021, nonfarm employment fell by 106,300, from 1,582,000 to 1,475,700. Agricultural employment decreased by 1,600, from 14,800 to 13,200.

- Leisure and hospitality led the year-over decline by deducting 57,600 jobs. Seventy-nine percent of the decrease was in accommodation and food services (down 45,700 jobs). Arts, entertainment, and recreation declined by 11,900 jobs.
- Seven other sectors experienced a reduction in employment over the year. The shortfalls were in government (down 21,900 jobs), other services (down 11,500 jobs), manufacturing (down 11,400 jobs), professional and business services (down 7,400 jobs), educational and health services (down 7,200 jobs), financial activities (down 3,000 jobs), and information (down 2,700 jobs).
- Year-over payroll gains were registered in trade, transportation, and utilities (up 16,100 jobs), construction (up 200 jobs), and mining and logging (up 100 jobs).
