# RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES) Nonfarm employment up 12,500 over the month; down 64,900 over the year 

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 7.7 percent in March 2021, down from a revised 8.1 percent in February 2021, and above the year-ago estimate of 4.6 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 8.2 percent for California and 6.2 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 7.7 percent in Riverside County, and 7.8 percent in San Bernardino County.

Between February 2021 and March 2021, total nonfarm employment grew from 1,497,200 to 1,509, 700, an increase of 12,500 jobs. Agricultural employment increased by 800 jobs.

- Leisure and hospitality (up 4,900 ) recorded the largest payroll increase over the month. Accommodation and food services (up 4,500) accounted for most of the job gain. Within accommodation and food services, food services and drinking places (up 3,800), recorded the largest employment increase, while accommodation added 700 jobs over the month. Arts, entertainment, and recreation grew by 400 jobs.
- Trade, transportation, and utilities (up 4,100) increased payrolls over the month, where transportation and warehousing (up 4,400) and retail trade (up 800) contributed to the gain. Wholesale trade receded by 1,100 .
- Additional employment gains were recorded in professional and business services (up 1,600), government (up 1,500), other services (up 1,000), construction (up 400), and information (up 100). Financial activities, manufacturing, and mining and logging remained unchanged.
- Educational and health services recorded the only employment loss over the month, receding by 1,100 .

Between March 2020 and March 2021, total nonfarm employment decreased by 64,900 (down 4.1 percent). Agricultural employment declined by 600 (down 4.3 percent).

- Leisure and hospitality (down 40,600) posted the largest decline over the year. Accommodation and food services (down 30,700 ) accounted for approximately three-fourths of the job loss, where employment in food services and drinking places (down 22,200 ) and accommodation (down 8,500 ) contracted. Arts, entertainment, and recreation (down 9,900) also registered job losses.
- Government employment fell by 24,200 . Employment decreases were recorded in local government (down 22,600), state government (down 1,000), and federal government (down 600).
- Additional year-over employment losses occurred in the following sectors: manufacturing (down 9,500 ), other services (down 7,800), educational and health services (down 5,400), professional and business services (down 4,000), financial activities (down 2,700), and information (down 2,400).
- Two industry sectors advanced employment levels over the year: trade, transportation, and utilities (up 29,400 ) and construction (up 2,300).
- Mining and logging remained unchanged.
