RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES) Nonfarm employment up 8,900 over the month and up 17,900 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 5.3 percent in August 2023, up from a revised 4.9 percent in July 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 4.3 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.1 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 5.4 percent in Riverside County, and 5.1 percent in San Bernardino County.

Between July 2023 and August 2023, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,659,400 to 1,668,300, an increase of 8,900 jobs. Agricultural employment decreased by 1,700 jobs.

- Government added the most jobs over the month increasing by 5,500 jobs. Local government added 6,000 jobs with most of the job growth registered in local government educational services (up 5,900). Federal government also increased by 100 jobs. Overall, job additions were offset by a loss of 600 jobs in state government.
- Private education and health services increased by 2,400 jobs. Seventy-nine percent of job additions registered in health care and social assistance (up 1,900). Private educational services also expanded by 500 jobs completing the overall increase. Three other sectors also increased over the month including trade, transportation, and utilities (up 2,300).
- Construction lost the most jobs over the month, declining by 1,400 jobs. All the decline was in specialty trade contractors (down 1,600). Construction of buildings and heavy and civil engineering construction offset declines by adding 100 jobs each. Four other sectors declined over the month and only mining and logging remained unchanged.

Between August 2022 and August 2023, total nonfarm employment increased by 17,900, a 1.1 percent change. Agricultural employment increased by 1,800 jobs or 15.2 percent.

- Private education and health services increased the most over the year adding 12,300 jobs.
 Ninety-three percent of the expansion registered in health care and social assistance (up 11,500).
 Private educational services added 800 jobs completing the overall sectoral increase.
- Government added 7,800 jobs. Local government increased by 7,900 jobs, followed by an increase of 600 jobs in federal government. State government offset job additions by losing 700 jobs. Three other sectors increased over the year, including construction (up 3,800).
- Trade, transportation, and utilities declined the most over the year losing 7,600 jobs. Wholesale trade (down 4,000) lost the most within the sector followed by losses in transportation, warehousing, and utilities (down 3,900). Retail trade offset declines by adding 300 jobs.
- Manufacturing lost 2,400 jobs. All the decline registered in durable goods (down 2,500). Non-durable goods added 100 jobs over the year. Two other sectors declined over the year: Information (down 500) and financial activities (down 200). Mining and logging and leisure and hospitality remained unchanged over the year.



The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 5.3 percent in August 2023, up from a revised 4.9 percent in July 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 4.3 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.1 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 5.4 percent in Riverside County, and 5.1 percent in San Bernardino County.
