The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 5.4 percent in November 2021, down from a revised 6.3 percent in October 2021, and below the year-ago estimate of 7.8 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.4 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 5.4 percent in Riverside County, and 5.5 percent in San Bernardino County.

Between October 2021 and November 2021, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,561,700 to 1,577,400, an increase of 15,700 jobs. Agricultural employment increased by 600 jobs.

- Trade, transportation, and utilities (up 12,600) recorded the largest payroll increase over the month. The payroll increase was noted in transportation, warehousing, and utilities (up 6,400), retail trade (up 5,300), and wholesale trade (up 900). Within transportation, warehousing, and utilities, transportation and warehousing (up 6,400) recorded all the job gain.
- Government (up 2,800) registered a payroll increase over the month. Local government (up 1,900), state government (up 700), and federal government (up 200) comprised the job gain. Within local government, local government educational services (up 1,300) recorded 68 percent of the job gain. Within state government, state government educational services (up 700) reported all the job gain.
- Additional employment gains were noted in the following sectors: leisure and hospitality (up 1,100), other services (up 700), educational and health services (up 500), manufacturing (up 500), and financial activities (up 200).
- Information and mining and logging did not change over the month. Whereas, employment losses were recorded in construction (down 2,500) and professional and business services (down 200).

Between November 2020 and November 2021, total nonfarm employment increased by 62,000 (up 4 percent). Agricultural employment decreased by 400 (down 3 percent).


- Trade, transportation, and utilities led the year-over increase, adding 19,300 jobs. The payroll increase
 was noted in transportation, warehousing, and utilities (up 12,400), retail trade (up 5,500), and
 wholesale trade (up 1,400).
- Leisure and hospitality advanced payrolls by 17,000 over the year. Within leisure and hospitality, accommodation and food services (up 15,600) accounted for most of the job gain. Arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 1,400) reported the remaining job gain.
- Additional year-over job gains occurred in the following sectors: educational and health services (up 12,300), other services (up 6,000), professional and business services (up 4,100), manufacturing (up 1,200), construction (up 1,100), financial activities (up 1,000), and information (up 600).
- Mining and logging remained unchanged over the year, but government (down 600) logged employment losses.
