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# RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES) Nonfarm employment up 18,000 over the month and up 98,300 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 5.0 percent in February 2022, down from a revised 5.7 percent in January 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 8.7 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 4.1 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 4.9 percent in Riverside County, and 5.0 percent in San Bernardino County.

**Between January 2022 and February 2022**, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,610,000 to 1,628,000, an increase of 18,000 jobs. Agricultural employment decreased by 700 jobs over the month.

- Leisure and hospitality (up 6,900) recorded the largest payroll increase over the month. The payroll increase was noted in accommodation and food services (up 6,300) and arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 600). Within accommodation and food services, food services and drinking places (up 5,800) and accommodation (up 500) encompassed the job gain.
- Construction (up 4,700) registered a payroll increase over the month. Within construction, specialty trade contractors (up 3,700) accounted for a majority of the job gain, while construction of buildings (up 600), and heavy and civil engineering construction (up 400) comprised the remaining payroll increase.
- Additional employment gains were noted in the following sectors: educational and health services (up 3,000), professional and business services (up 2,700), manufacturing (up 1,400), financial activities (up 700), other services (up 300), and information (up 100).
- Mining and logging did not change over the month. Employment losses were recorded in trade, transportation, and utilities (down 1.600) and government (down 200).

**Between February 2021 and February 2022,** total nonfarm employment increased by 98,300 (up 6.4 percent). Agricultural employment increased by 900 (up 6.8 percent).


- Leisure and hospitality led the year-over increase, adding 31,400 jobs. Within leisure and hospitality, accommodation and food services (up 26,100) accounted for most of the job gain. Arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 5,300) reported the remaining job gain.
- Trade, transportation, and utilities advanced payrolls by 31,000 over the year. Payroll increases were
  noted in transportation, warehousing, and utilities (up 22,800), retail trade (up 7,000), and wholesale
  trade (up 1,200).
- Additional year-over job gains occurred in the following sectors: government (up 14,200), educational
  and health services (up 6,900), professional and business services (up 5,700), other services (up
  3,500), manufacturing (up 2,400), financial activities (up 1,200), information (up 1,100), and
  construction (up 900).
- Mining and logging remained unchanged over the year.

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 5.0 percent in February 2022, down from a revised 5.7 percent in January 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 8.7 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 4.1 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 4.9 percent in Riverside County, and 5.0 percent in San Bernardino County.
