# RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES)

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The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 3.8 percent in April 2022, down from a revised 4.3 percent in March 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 8.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 3.8 percent for California and 3.3 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 3.8 percent in Riverside County and 3.8 percent in San Bernardino County.

Nonfarm employment up 10,100 over the month and up 92,200 over the year

**Between March 2022 and April 2022**, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,634,200 to 1,644,300, an increase of 10,100 jobs. Agricultural employment increased by 100 jobs over the month.

- Leisure and hospitality (up 3,300) recorded an employment increase over the month. The employment increase was noted in accommodation and food services (up 3,800), while arts, entertainment, and recreation (down 500) reported a job loss.
- Professional and business services (up 3,300) registered a payroll increase over the month.
   Administrative and support and waste management and remediation services (up 1,700) and professional, scientific, and technical services (up 1,600) comprised the job increase, whereas management of companies and enterprises remained unchanged.
- Additional employment gains were noted in the following sectors: educational and health services (up 2,500), government (up 1,800), construction (up 1,300), manufacturing (up 500), and financial activities (up 200).
- Other services, information, and mining and logging did not change over the month. An employment loss was recorded in trade, transportation, and utilities (down 2,800).

**Between April 2021 and April 2022**, total nonfarm employment increased by 92,200 (up 5.9 percent). Agricultural employment increased by 1,200 (up 8.9 percent).

- Trade, transportation, and utilities led the year-over increase, adding 34,000 jobs. Payroll increases were noted in transportation, warehousing, and utilities (up 24,600), retail trade (up 8,300), and wholesale trade (up 1,100).
- Leisure and hospitality advanced payrolls by 22,600 over the year. Within leisure and hospitality, accommodation and food services (up 20,000) accounted for most of the job gain. Arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 2,600) reported the remaining job gain.
- Additional year-over job gains occurred in the following sectors: government (up 13,400), educational and health services (up 8,400), professional and business services (up 6,600), manufacturing (up 2,800), other services (up 2,300), financial activities (up 2,000), and information (up 400).
- Employment losses were noted in construction (down 200) and mining and logging (down 100).


