**RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
(RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES)**  
**Nonfarm employment up 2,800 over the month and up 83,700 over the year**

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 3.4 percent in May 2022, down from a revised 3.8 percent in April 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 7.5 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 3.4 percent for California and 3.4 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 3.4 percent in Riverside County and 3.4 percent in San Bernardino County.

**Between April 2022 and May 2022**, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,644,500 to 1,647,300, an increase of 2,800 jobs. Agricultural employment increased by 1,300 jobs over the month.

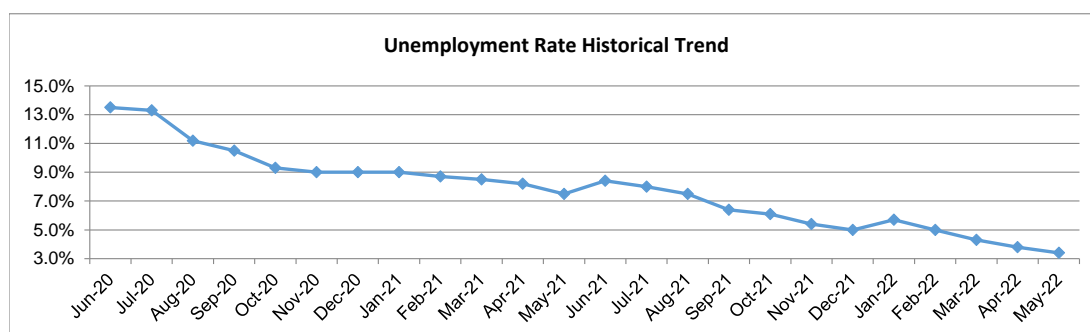
- Leisure and hospitality (up 2,700) recorded the largest payroll increase over the month. The payroll increase was noted in accommodation and food services (up 3,000), while arts, entertainment, and recreation (down 300) reported a job loss. Within accommodation and food services, the increase was comprised of food services and drinking places (up 2,700) and accommodation (up 300).
- Government (up 1,800) registered an employment increase over the month. Local government (up 1,700) and state government (up 100) comprised the job increase, whereas federal government remained unchanged.
- Additional employment gains were noted in the following sectors: manufacturing (up 900), other services (up 400), educational and health services (up 300), and information (up 200).
- Mining and logging did not change over the month, whereas employment losses were recorded in the following sectors: trade, transportation, and utilities (down 1,200), financial activities (down 1,000), professional and business services (down 800), and construction (down 500).

**Between May 2021 and May 2022**, total nonfarm employment increased by 83,700 (up 5.4 percent). Agricultural employment increased by 1,500 (up 10.3 percent).

- Trade, transportation, and utilities led the year-over increase, adding 31,100 jobs. Payroll increases were noted in transportation, warehousing, and utilities (up 24,900), retail trade (up 3,900), and wholesale trade (up 2,300).
- Leisure and hospitality advanced payrolls by 21,300 over the year. Within leisure and hospitality, accommodation and food services (up 19,100) accounted for most of the job gain. Arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 2,200) reported the remaining job gain.
- Additional year-over job gains occurred in the following sectors: government (up 13,400), educational and health services (up 7,500), manufacturing (up 3,900), professional and business services (up 3,400), other services (up 1,900), financial activities (up 1,700), and information (up 300).
- Mining and logging remained unchanged over the year, whereas an employment loss was noted in construction (down 800).
