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RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES) <u>Nonfarm employment down 4,000 over the month and up 84,400 over the year</u>

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 3.9 percent in July 2022, down from a revised 4.0 percent in June 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 8.0 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 3.9 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 4.0 percent in Riverside County, and 3.9 percent in San Bernardino County.

Between June 2022 and July 2022, total nonfarm employment decreased from 1,655,500 to 1,651,500, a decrease of 4,000 jobs. Agricultural employment decreased by 2,100 jobs over the month.

- Government (down 13,500) recorded the only payroll decrease over the month. Local government (down 12,800) and state government (down 1,100) accounted for all the job loss. Federal government added 400 jobs over the month. Within local government, local government educational services (down 12,000) was responsible for 93.8 percent of the employment loss. Within state government, state government educational services (down 1,100) incurred all the job loss.
- Trade, transportation, and utilities (up 2,300) registered the largest payroll increase over the month. The payroll increase was noted in retail trade (up 1,500), wholesale trade (up 600), and transportation, warehousing, and utilities (up 200).
- Additional employment gains were noted in the following sectors: construction (up 2,100), leisure and hospitality (up 2,000), educational and health services (up 1,200), professional and business services (up 1,100), financial activities (up 700), and other services (up 100).
- Information, manufacturing, and mining and logging remained unchanged over the month.


Between July 2021 and July 2022, total nonfarm employment increased by 84,400 (up 5.4 percent). Agricultural employment increased by 2,400 (up 17.7 percent).

- Trade, transportation, and utilities led the year-over increase, adding 34,200 jobs. Payroll increases were noted in transportation, warehousing, and utilities (up 24,600), retail trade (up 6,700), and wholesale trade (up 2,900).
- Leisure and hospitality advanced payrolls by 16,200 over the year. Within leisure and hospitality, accommodation and food services (up 16,000) accounted for most of the job gain. Arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 200) reported the remaining job gain.
- Further year-over job gains occurred in the following sectors: educational and health services (up 10,000), government (up 9,800), professional and business services (up 5,600), manufacturing (up 4,200), construction (up 2,500), and financial activities (up 1,900).
- Other services, information, and mining and logging remained unchanged over the year.
