# RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES) Nonfarm employment up 9,300 over the month and up 89,300 over the year

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The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 4.2 percent in August 2022, up from a revised 4.0 percent in July 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 7.5 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.1 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 4.3 percent in Riverside County, and 4.2 percent in San Bernardino County.

**Between August 2022 and September 2022**, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,653,800 to 1,663,100, an increase of 9,300 jobs. Agricultural employment decreased by 3,400 jobs over the month.

- Government (up 3,800) recorded the largest payroll increase over the month. Local government (up 4,800), accounted for all the job gain in this industry. Both State government (down 800) and federal government (down 200) recorded payroll reductions.
- Professional and business services (up 3,300) registered the second largest employment increase over the month. The payroll increase was noted in administrative and support and waste services (up 2,600), professional, scientific, and technical services (up 600), and management of companies and enterprises (up 100).
- Additional employment gains were recorded in three other sectors: education and health services (up 2,400), trade, transportation, and utilities (up 1,300), and leisure and hospitality (up 600).
- Six other sectors recorded job losses, with other services (down 900) and construction (down 600) recording the largest job losses.


**Between August 2021 and August 2022,** total nonfarm employment increased by 89,300 (up 5.7 percent). Agricultural employment increased by 200 (up 1.6 percent).

- Trade, transportation, and utilities led the year-over increase, adding 32,400 jobs. Payroll increases
  were registered in transportation, warehousing, and utilities (up 22,900), retail trade (up 6,200), and
  wholesale trade (up 3,300).
- Leisure and hospitality expanded payrolls by 17,100 over the year. Within leisure and hospitality, accommodation and food services (up 16,600) accounted for over 97 percent of all the job gain in this sector. Arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 500) reported the remaining job gain.
- The following sectors also recorded employment gains: government (up 11,400), educational and health services (up 11,300), professional and business services (up 10,200), manufacturing (up 4,200), construction (up 2,100), and financial activities (up 1,700).
- Other services (down 1,000) and mining and logging (down 100) recorded payroll reductions.
