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**RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES)**

Nonfarm employment up 6,700 over the month and up 13,000 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 4.5 percent in February 2023, up from a revised 4.4 percent in January 2023, and below the year-ago estimate of 4.7 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 4.5 percent in Riverside County, and 4.5 percent in San Bernardino County.

Between January 2023 and February 2023, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,662,200 to 1,668,900, an increase of 6,700 jobs. Agricultural employment decreased by 400 jobs.

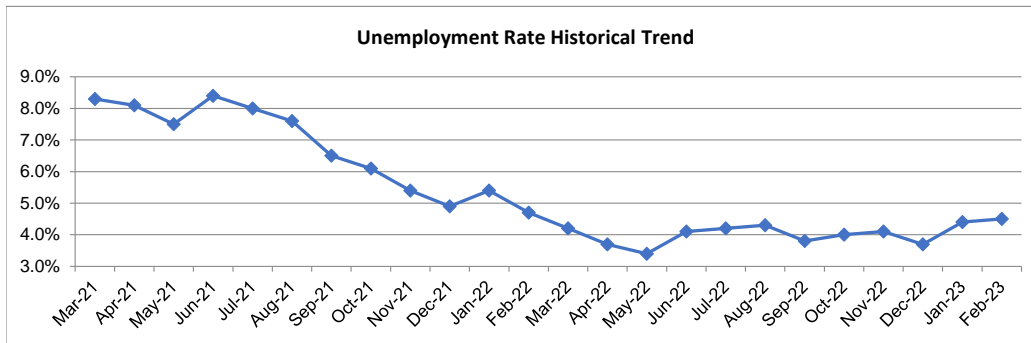
- Leisure and hospitality gained the most jobs over the month adding 3,200 jobs. Ninety-seven percent of job additions registered in accommodation and food services (up 3,100). Arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 100) completed overall sectoral increases.
- Five other sectors increased over the month including construction (up 2,800), private education and health services (up 2,600), and other services (up 1,600). Three sectors remained unchanged: government, information, and mining and logging.
- Trade, transportation, and utilities lost the most jobs over the month declining by 4,600. Transportation, warehousing, and utilities declined the most within the sector (down 3,400) with all of the contraction registered in transportation and warehousing (down 3,400). Retail trade also lost 1,500 jobs. Wholesale trade offset losses with 300 job additions. One other sector declined over the month: financial activities (down 100).

Between February 2022 and February 2023, total nonfarm employment increased by 13,000, a 0.8 percent change. Agricultural employment increased by 400 jobs, or 2.9 percent.

- Private education and health services added the most over the year, increasing by 10,400 jobs. Most of the job expansion was in health care and social assistance (up 10,300). Private educational services completed the overall job growth (up 100).
- Government added 6,600 jobs. All of the job increases registered in local government (up 6,900) but were offset by declines in both state government (down 200) and federal government (down 100).
- Four other sectors gained jobs over the year, including professional and business services (up 3,700) and other services (up 2,600). Two sectors remained unchanged: mining and logging and information.
- Three sectors declined over the year with trade, transportation, and utilities (down 12,300) losing the most jobs. Within the sector, the largest reduction recorded was in transportation, warehousing, and utilities (down 11,700), followed by losses in wholesale trade (down 1,600). Retail trade offset declines increasing by 1,000 jobs. Two additional sectors lost jobs over the year: financial Activities (down 800) and manufacturing (down 500).
