RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES) Nonfarm employment up 7,100 over the month and up 12,100 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 4.1 percent in April 2023, down from a revised 4.6 percent in March 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.7 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.3 percent for California and 3.1 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 4.1 percent in Riverside County, and 4.1 percent in San Bernardino County.

Between March 2023 and April 2023, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,664,200 to 1,671,300, an increase of 7,100 jobs. Agricultural employment remained unchanged.

- Construction increased the most over the month adding 4,000 jobs. Ninety percent of the job
 expansion was in the specialty trade contractors (up 3,600) subsector. Heavy and civil engineering
 construction gained 300 jobs and construction of buildings increased by 100 jobs completing the
 overall sectoral employment gain.
- Leisure and hospitality added 1,600 jobs. All the employment gain was in accommodation and food services (up 1,900), more specifically in food services and drinking places (up 1,900). Arts, entertainment, and recreation offset job gains with a decline of 300 jobs. Five other sectors increased over the month: private education and health services (up 1,200), professional and business services (up 900), other services (up 800), financial activities (up 700), and government (up 500).
- Only two sectors declined over the month. Trade, transportation, and utilities declined the most over the month losing 1,900 jobs. Most of the job loss was in transportation, warehousing, and utilities (down 1,800), more specifically in transportation and warehousing (down 1,800). Retail trade declined by 100 jobs and wholesale trade remained unchanged over the month, completing the overall sectoral decline. Mining and logging and information remained unchanged.

Between April 2022 and April 2023, total nonfarm employment increased by 12,100, a 0.7 percent change. Agricultural employment increased by 200 jobs or 1.4 percent.

- Private education and health services added the most jobs over the year, increasing by 13,400.
 Ninety-nine percent of the job gain was recorded in health care and social assistance adding 13,200 jobs. Private educational services added 200 jobs completing the overall sectoral increase.
- Government gained 7,700 jobs. Local government increased by 7,800 jobs over the year, followed by gains in federal government (up 200). State government offset increases with a loss of 300 jobs. Two other sectors increased over the year: professional and business services (up 2,300) and other services (up 2,200).
- Trade, transportation, and utilities lost the most jobs over the year dropping by 8,000.
 Transportation, warehousing, and utilities declined by 5,200 jobs followed by declines in both
 wholesale trade (down 2,700) and retail trade (down 100). Five other sectors declined including
 manufacturing (down 3,600) and leisure and hospitality (down 1,000). Mining and logging remained
 unchanged.

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
