# RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES) Nonfarm employment up 7,400 over the month and up 16,600 over the year 

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 4.4 percent in May 2023, up from a revised 4.1 percent in April 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.4 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.5 percent for California and 3.4 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 4.4 percent in Riverside County, and 4.3 percent in San Bernardino County.

Between April 2023 and May 2023, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,668,700 to 1,676,100, an increase of 7,400 jobs. Agricultural employment increased by 1,500 jobs.

- Construction gained the most over the month adding 3,400 jobs. Specialty trade contractors (up 2,600 ) led job gains in the sector. Construction of buildings (up 500) and heavy and civil engineering construction (up 300) completed the overall sectoral increase.
- Government increased by 1,100 jobs. Within the sector, local government gained the most adding 1,000 jobs followed by an increase of 100 jobs in state government. Federal government remained unchanged.
- Five other industries added jobs over the month: other services (up 900), trade, transportation, and utilities (up 900), leisure and hospitality (up 800), financial activities (up 400), and professional and business services (up 300).
- Manufacturing was the only sector to lose jobs over the month (down 400). Durable goods declined by 300 jobs and non-durable goods declined by 100 jobs. Three sectors remained unchanged over the month: private education and health services, information, and mining and logging.

Between May 2022 and May 2023, total nonfarm employment increased by 16,600, a 1.0 percent change. Agricultural employment increased by 800 jobs or 5.4 percent.

- Private education and health services gained the most jobs over the year adding 12,400 jobs. Ninety-eight percent of the job additions were in health care and social assistance (up 12,100). Private educational services (up 300) completed the overall sectoral increase.
- Government added 7,700 jobs over the year. Local government (up 8,100 ) added the most jobs within the sector followed by increases in federal government (up 100). State government offset increases with a decline of 500 jobs. Three other sectors increased over the year: professional and business services (up 3,400), other services (up 2,200), and construction (up 2,200).
- Four sectors declined over the year. Trade, transportation, and utilities lost the most jobs over the year cutting back 5,800 jobs. Sixty-nine percent of the decline was in transportation, warehousing, and utilities (down 4,000), more specifically in transportation and warehousing (down 4,400). Within transportation and warehousing the largest decline recorded was in couriers and messengers (down 3,100). Wholesale trade also declined within the sector losing 2,500 jobs. Retail trade offset overall sectoral declines with an increase of 700 jobs. Financial activities and mining and logging remained unchanged.

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 4.4 percent in May 2023, up from a revised 4.1 percent in April 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.4 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.5 percent for California and 3.4 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 4.4 percent in Riverside County, and 4.3 percent in San Bernardino County.
