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**RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES)**

Nonfarm employment down 9,400 over the month and up 17,800 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 4.9 percent in July 2023, down from a revised 5.0 percent in June 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 4.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 5.0 percent in Riverside County, and 4.8 percent in San Bernardino County.

Between June 2023 and July 2023, total nonfarm employment decreased from 1,671,600 to 1,662,200, a decrease of 9,400 jobs. Agricultural employment decreased by 1,800 jobs.

- Government lost 12,900 jobs over the month, the most of any other sector. Most of the loss was in local government (down 12,700), more specifically in local government educational services (down 13,300) and in line with schools going into summer break. State government lost 300 jobs. Losses were offset by a gain of 100 jobs in federal government.
- Financial activities decreased by 900 jobs. Real estate and rental and leasing (down 600) lost the most over the month within the sector followed by losses in finance and insurance (down 300). Two other sectors decreased over the month, professional and business services and private education and health services, which both lost 300 jobs each.
- Construction added 3,100 jobs over the month. 3,000 of those jobs registered in specialty trade contractors. Construction of buildings added 100 jobs and heavy and civil engineering construction remained unchanged completing the overall sectoral increase.
- Leisure and hospitality gained 800 jobs. All the increase registered was in accommodation and food services (up 1,100), more specifically in food services and drinking places (up 1,100). Arts entertainment, and recreation lost 300 jobs over the month offsetting the overall sectoral increase. Three other sectors increased over the month and only two sectors remained unchanged: information and mining and logging.

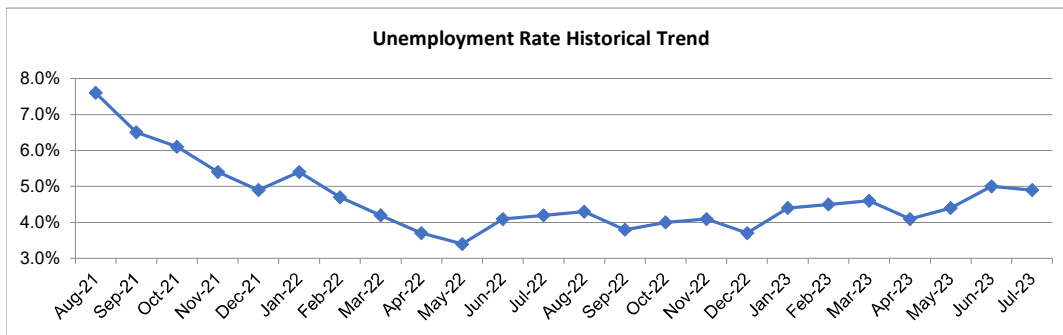
Between July 2022 and July 2023, total nonfarm employment increased by 17,800, a 1.1 percent change. Agricultural employment increased by 2,000 jobs or 15.0 percent.

- Private education and health services gained the most jobs over the year adding 13,800 jobs. Eighty-two percent of the increase was in health care and social assistance (up 11,300). Private educational services added 2,500 jobs. Five other sectors added jobs over the year.
- Trade, transportation, and utilities lost the most jobs over the year decreasing by 12,600 jobs. Transportation, warehousing, and utilities lost 8,600 jobs, of which transportation and warehousing (down 9,000) accounted for all the decline. Wholesale trade (down 3,500) and retail trade (down 500) also declined completing the overall sectoral decline.
- Manufacturing lost 2,900 jobs. All the loss registered was in durable goods (down 3,100). Non-durable goods offset declines by adding 200 jobs. Financial activities (down 500) and information (down 300) also declined over the year. Mining and logging remained unchanged.
