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# RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES) <u>Nonfarm employment up 14,000 over the month and up 30,000 over the year</u>

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 5.1 percent in November 2023, unchanged from a revised 5.1 percent in October 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 4.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.9 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 5.1 percent in Riverside County, and 5.0 percent in San Bernardino County.

**Between October 2023 and November 2023,** total nonfarm employment increased from 1,705,000 to 1,719,000, an increase of 14,000 jobs. Agricultural employment increased by 700 jobs.

- Trade, transportation, and utilities gained the most jobs over the month adding 11,200 jobs. Transportation, warehousing, and utilities and retail trade both added 5,600 jobs each, while wholesale trade remained unchanged.
- Government increased by 1,600 jobs. Most of the job gain recorded was in local government (up 1,500), more specifically in local government educational services (up 1,200). Federal government also increased by 100 jobs and state government remained unchanged completing the overall sectoral gain. Five other industries added jobs over the month including other services (up 1,300).
- Construction declined the most, losing 1,800 jobs. Eighty-three percent of the decline was in specialty trade contractors (down 1,500), followed by a decline in construction of buildings (down 300). Heavy and civil engineering construction remained unchanged. Only two other sectors declined including manufacturing and professional and business services (down 100 each). Mining and logging remained unchanged.

**Between November 2022 and November 2023,** total nonfarm employment increased by 30,000, a 1.8 percent change. Agricultural employment increased by 200 jobs or 1.3 percent.

- Private education and health services added 12,400 jobs over the year. All the job expansion registered in health care and social assistance (up 12,500). Private educational services offset job additions with a decline of 100 jobs.
- Government expanded by 10,800 jobs. Most job additions were in local government (up 10,600), followed by an addition of 900 jobs in federal government. State government offset job increases with a decline of 700 jobs. Four other sectors added jobs over the month including construction (up 9,700).
- Trade, transportation, and utilities lost the most jobs over the year (down 2,700). Wholesale trade (down 3,800) lost the most within the sector, with merchant wholesalers, durable goods (down 2,700) losing the most within the subsector. Transportation, warehousing, and utilities also lost 900 jobs over the year. Retail trade offset declines with an addition of 2,000 jobs completing the overall sectoral decline. Three other sectors declined over the year, including financial activities (down 2,400). Mining and logging remained unchanged.



## IMMEDIATE RELEASE RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Riverside and San Bernardino Counties)

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 5.1 percent in November 2023, unchanged from a revised 5.1 percent in October 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 4.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.9 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 5.1 percent in Riverside County, and 5.0 percent in San Bernardino County.
