# Request for Partnership AB 1111 Breaking Barriers to Employment Initiative

This notice shall serve as a procedural document for qualified Community Based Organizations (CBOs) seeking partnership with the San Bernardino County Workforce Development Board (WDB) for funding through the AB1111 Breaking Barriers to Employment Initiative.

#### Criteria

The WDB will consider supporting applications for AB 1111 funding by providing a letter of partnership that includes intent to establish a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). Entities requesting a letter of partnership must submit a two page maximum summary of their proposal. These requests should address the following:

- Describe the type of organization requesting the letter of partnership including whether the organization has 501(c)(3) status.
- Confirm the organization's capacity to serve as the lead applicant and fiscal agent for the grant program.
- Describe how the organization's mission and vision align with that of the WDB.
- Describe the proposed project, including:
  - A description of the proposed program including services to be provided.
  - The target population(s) and number of individuals to be served.
  - The location(s) where services will be provided.
  - Explanation affirming the project and its activities do not duplicate services already provided by the WDB's America's Job Centers of California or GenerationGo! Youth program.
  - How this project and its activities align with the WDB's 2017-2020 local plan http://wp.sbcounty.gov/workforce/about/strategic-priorities/.
- If the proposal is industry based, identify which of the following in-demand industries identified by the WDB will be served:
  - Transportation/Logistics
  - Manufacturing
  - Health Care
  - Construction, and
  - Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services

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- Describe the level of anticipated partnership with the WDB.
- Describe how required matching funds will be paid. Please include funding source(s) and amount.

In addition, the request must include the following information:

- Name of organization and address
- Point of contact, title, email and telephone number
- History and background information on the organization

<u>Please Note:</u> Due to funding from the Prison to Employment (P2E) initiative, other underserved populations may have a priority of service for San Bernardino County's AB 1111 partnerships. Applications that are able to provide quality services County-wide will have a higher priority in the review process.

All requests for letter of partnership with the WDB must be submitted via email by <u>3 pm on Friday</u>, <u>August 9, 2019</u> to:
