7) Community Strategic Plans

Jonathan Weldy led this topic and discussed the need for representation on the committee for each of the special populations. The members reviewed a report with data provided by United Way (211), which showed the various populations. After some discussion, it was determined the Workforce Development Department (WDD) and the Employment Development Department (EDD) should appear as partners in all categories that provide services. Also discussed was the reliability of the data, as not all individuals in these special populations self-report their specific disability. In addition, we are the aggregator of the information provided, not the collector, so while the data in these reports is reasonably accurate, it is not 100% accurate. Mr. Weldy noted that it would be beneficial if we had someone at the AJCC office who has specialty training to best work with the individuals that may come into the office. Additional topics discussed included narrowing down the number of populations, so we can find a common denominator and move the needle. An area of priority is resolving the transportation problem that many encounter. Perhaps looking at the current taxi services or speak with the Transportation Authority. All of these would require additional funding, as well.
