## 7) Disability Navigator

Curtis Compton introduced Vanessa Suberville, who speaks with employers in San Bernardino County about the benefits of hiring people with disabilities. A discussion ensued regarding challenges she encounters when working with the businesses. Ms. Suberville stated employers can be hesitant to hire people with disabilities, as they don't think they can do the job. She educates those businesses about individuals with disabilities and asks them to identify the barrier the business is seeing, so she can look at ways to overcome those barriers. She also lets the employer know that we can provide supportive services to help those individuals. Lastly, the committee members discussed status updates at a future meeting to see if we are making an impact getting businesses to hire individuals with disabilities.

## 8) Special Populations Dashboard

Fred Burks provided an update regarding the development of a dashboard for the Special Populations Committee to review. Much of the information can be collected from CalJOBS but it also requires individuals to self-report their disabilities or we would not have a complete picture with accurate data. Some of the challenges in getting these individuals to self-report is their misunderstanding that they might not get services if they disclose that information.
