**Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order at 6:30p.m, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

**Approval of Minutes**

The minutes for March 22, 2012 were approved. Derek Leistra moved and Leslie Dodge-Taylor seconded to accept the minutes.

**Correspondence & Announcements by MAC members**

Leslie Dodge-Taylor completed her ethics training. The training will be emailed to each member to complete.

Lewis Murray is going to check with the Clerk of the Board to see if the MAC meeting minutes can be posted online.

Lewis Murray is going to attach the meeting minutes when he sends out the notice for the meetings.

Derek Leistra attended a rally in Washington D.C. for the realtor's rights, he was one of 15,000 realtors that rallied at the Washington monument to champion realtor's rights. It was a huge success.

**Discussion Items:**

**Lake Gregory Improvement Committee**

Rick Dinon discussed the updates on the Lake Gregory Dam Committee. A preliminary engineering evaluation was completed for the repairs of the dam. This included about a dozen options, which is good news because there are a variety of ways the dam can be fixed. With regard

to pricing the options range from a couple of million dollars to double digits. Next, the consultant submitted a second report to them and now the options are down to 3 or 4 that are the more affordable options. However, all of these options will produce traffic and noise in the area. The County staff is reviewing the report and they are going to make a selection from these options and then that option will go to the Department of the Safety of Dams. After rounds of questions and answers, a bid sequence will be produced. Then a budgetary sequence, an award and then the project will begin on the dam. In the past three months there has been considerable forward movement with this project.

Dredging for the lake is on schedule. The County has an agreement with Public Works where they pay a premium so the process can move along rapidly.

Rick Dinon met with Supervisor Rutherford and discussed the park, she said the County is open for ideas that will drive revenue, traffic, reduce expense and make it more attractive.

Supervisor Rutherford put a line item in the proposed budget for 4 million to be spent on the Lake Gregory Dam repairs.

Lewis Murray addressed previous questions raised at meetings. The Park and Ride lights are maintained by Caltrans, not the County. Therefore, Caltrans would need to come and replace them. Then Lewis spoke about the Façade Program and will look into it to discuss next meeting. The County has taken the next step to create the scenic highway. The funding was approved for a recreational road in the mountain area, to get people off of highway 18 and into the community. Signs will go up shortly.
