a. Lake Gregory Community Advisory Committee Report: Bill Mellinger

Chair Bill Mellinger discussed the following topics:

- Initial meetings and communication
 - Mellinger shared that the recently appointed advisory committee initially met with Supervisor Rutherford to go over the goals and objectives of the committee. They have since met with Director of Regional Parks Beahtha Davis, as well as other County staff who will be involved in management and communication.
 - Mellinger then gave the following report: The restrooms continue to be open, Cal Fire has been performing some trail maintenance, the Pilot Rock crew will be assisting with Christmas lighting. Silt basin clean-up will be done soon. No dredging this year. No information on the

concessionaire. Should know soon. Hoping that the North Beach will be open this year. He then answered questions from the attendees.

5.0 Community & Agency Updates:

a. Government Agencies represented

Cal Fire: Division Chief Tony Jones discussed the closure of Pilot Rock Camp. He stated that it is primarily a budget issue. The State Legislature/Governor gave direction to Cal Fire to de-populate camps and relocate assets. There is also a shortage of qualified inmates to serve at the camps. The camp will be closed as of December 31. He then answered questions from the audience.

CHP: Sgt. Alex Barajas shared that CHP recently met with Cal Trans to discuss winter operations. There was a recent snow storm that created some challenges. Hwy 38 was closed down. They were on tactical alert for the election but so far, no incidents in our area. He discussed the CHiPs for Kids program.

6.0 Correspondence & Announcements from Board Members: Dinon shared that he participated in the annual Lake Gregory clean-up. 17 people participated on October 17th. They picked up 19 bags of trash.
