3.0 Reports

- **Supervisor's Report:** Supervisor Janice Rutherford provided an update on the Covid 19 situation. She discussed case levels, testing, vaccination, and many other topics related to the pandemic. The Supervisor also discussed the upcoming restricting requirement and provided an application for anyone interested in serving on the commission.
- **San Bernardino County Fire Chief Dan Munsey:** Chief Munsey discussed some of his personal strategies for improving County Fire. He believes that County Fire needs to be more proactive, preventing fires from occurring in the first place. His "3 Cs" are Community, Collaboration, and Communication. He is working through the County on legislative fixes, which is unique to SB County. He also covered chipping programs. He then answered questions from the audience.
- **San Bernardino County Public Works, Brendon Biggs:** The primary topic was related to a request from a resident to make San Moritz Drive one-way. Brendon Biggs provided information as well as a PowerPoint presentation describing the situation and the pros and cons of making this change. He also mentioned they are surveying nearby residents who may be impacted.
- **Lake Gregory Report: Lake Gregory Community Advisory Committee:** Advisory Board member Gil Flores, Chair Steve Garcia, and new Lake Gregory GM Nathan Godwin gave an update on the status of the agreement. gave an updated on the agreement between the County and Lake Gregory Community Recreation Company.

4.0 Community & Agency Updates:

- **San Bernardino County Sheriff:** Captain Lupear shared that the Sheriff's snow patrol has been out enforcing snow play impacts. He discussed the recent vaccination events up here. Both were smooth with no issues. The Twin Peaks Station is at full strength. He invited everyone to attend Coffee with a Cop on Friday at Snow Valley.
- **CHP:** Lt. Salinas said that the past month has been mostly uneventful. Business as usual. He is trying to recruit more tow truck companies up here to respond.
- **County Fire:** Battalion Chief Rapoza said that call volume is down a bit. They are participating in mandatory trainings and focusing on community risk reduction. They are also working on creating veteran hand crews that would provide training and potential employment to veterans.
- **Crestline Chamber of Commerce:** Kathy Creighton shared that the Chamber is gearing up for events this summer and fall.
- **Lake Arrowhead MAC:** Chair Scott Rindenow discussed topics being covered at the Lake Arrowhead MAC and invited everyone to attend on Thursday.
