- **Rim of the World Unified School District:** Dana Ridland, board president, shared students are now back in class on a hybrid schedule. She discussed other issues impacting the district.

- **Lake Arrowhead MAC:** Chair Scott Rindenow discussed topics being covered at the Lake Arrowhead MAC. He also mentioned the passing of long-time resident and community leader Carol Banner.
