**3.0 Lake Gregory Report: Lake Gregory Community Advisory Committee:** Advisory Board members Steve Farrell and Gil Flores gave a report on the recent community meeting. Overall, the meeting went well. There was a good turn-out by the community. A presentation was made and then questions from the community were addressed.

Steve Garcia from Lake Gregory Community Recreation Company updated the MAC regarding repairs, improvements, new equipment, boats, kayaks, etc. They are aiming for a soft opening on May 21.

### **4.0 Community & Government Updates:**

- **United States Forest Service:** Brian Grant discussed current staffing levels. He also discussed campground openings, fire restrictions, the Keller Peak clearance project, and the delay of the Grass Valley burning project.
- **San Bernardino County Fire:** Bryan James discussed back country patrols and response. He also discussed fire season and updated a current fire burning in the Cajon Pass. He also mentioned that

residents can contact County Fire for recommendations regarding defensible space.

- **San Bernardino County Sheriff:** Captain Lupear shared that the Sheriff's OHV patrols will continue this year. They should begin soon. There have been several rescue operations, mostly lost hikers. The Sheriff's boat will be back on Lake Arrowhead and Lake Silverwood. There are openings for the Citizens on Patrol team. He recently met with representatives of the Lake Gregory Recreation Company regarding parking, signage, and other issues. Discussed the use of goats to cut down on fire danger and issues related to camping in the forest.
- **CHP:** Sgt. Griede shared that hwy 330 will be closed on May 17 and 18 for maintenance. They are currently training with new vehicles. He recommended that you plan ahead this summer as they are anticipating more traffic than usual.
- **Crestline Chamber of Commerce:** Kathy Creighton shared that the Chamber is gearing up for events this summer and fall. They are planning on Jamboree Days as well as fireworks on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of July.
- **Elected Official's Representatives:** Senator Rosilicie Ochoa Bogh's Office: Sidney Sonck gave a state legislative update on several bills being considered by the Legislature.

**5.0 Supervisor's Report:** Lewis Murray shared information and statistics related to Covid 19 cases and vaccinations. He discussed information related to the Board of Supervisor's meetings. Also, Hazzard Weed Abatement inspections are starting any day. He suggested homeowners clear their properties per County Code.
