- a. San Bernardino County Weed Abatement. Michelle Palmer, Andres Diaz, and Douglas Craig from San Bernardino County Code Enforcement made a presentation. They discussed the updated abatement process including photos and descriptions. They answered questions from the audience.

<u>CHP:</u> Lt. Lupear discussed that it has been slow. He shared the 2018 annual crime stats. OHV patrol. Received additional funding. Boat patrols begin next week on Lake Arrowhead. Shifting focus to Lake Silverwood. Answered questions from the audience

Lake Gregory Recreation Company: Arlene Arenas. Discussed recent successful events. Discussed the issues related to the docks. They are damaged beyond repair, Discussed summer opening and upcoming summer events. Answered questions regarding trash, ball fields, etc.

<u>Rim of the World Recreation & Park District</u>: Hugh Bialecki gave an update on the Park District. Preparing for summer activities. Preparing facilities, irrigation etc. No plans to pursue a park next to VOE.
