5.0 Community & Government Updates: *This is an opportunity for Community Representatives & Government agencies to update the LAMAC on items of interest to the Lake Arrowhead Communities.*

- **Sheriff:** Captain Don Lupear, SBSB reminded everyone that snow is coming. He is looking forward to leaving fire season for a while. They have removed the Sheriff's boat from Lake Arrowhead for the winter. The OHV patrols continue. As a result several homeless camps have been discovered and dispersed. The Twin Peaks station is fully staffed and there have been no Covid cases reported among staff or law enforcement officers. They are making winter plans. He is anticipating large crowds this year. He also dispelled the rumor that suicides are increasing in the mountains.
- **CHP:** Sgt. Alex Barajas shared that they recently met with Cal Trans and other partners to update plans for winter conditions. They are increasing staffing to assist with chain control. They have also increased patrols in the area of Grass Valley Road and Clubhouse due to speeding issues. There have been no political-based issues in the mountains that they have had to respond to.

- **Rim of the World School District:** Cindy Gardner shared that they successfully applied for a waiver that allows limited opening of elementary level classrooms. Rim School District is well prepared and well stocked with masks, sanitizer, etc. to meet requirements. Unfortunately, someone graffitied the school. School bus drivers have been priming and painting over.
- **Cal Trans:** Shane Masoud gave an update on Cal Trans activities in the mountains. The guardrail project on Hwy 189 is going well and on schedule. The Hwy 173 realignment project between Hospital Road and Torrey Road is on hold for now. Most winter preparations were performed in the summer. They have cleared drains, removed rocks and boulders, cleaned out culverts, and inspected embankments. All yards are open and staff has been increased for the winter.
- **Lake Arrowhead Village:** Erin Wiley shared that they are looking for tenants and plan on adding four new kiosks. Construction continues on building K – the location of the new CVS store. They intend on servicing and rebuilding the elevator. They are adding new LED lighting and have hired a consultant to assist them with redesigning all signage in the Village. Halloween was a big success. They are working on holiday schedule and events.
- **Arrowhead Lake Association:** Bob Mattison discussed the new ALA Short Term Rental regulation. He shared plans for enforcement and the fine schedule. This weekend is the Junior Trout Rodeo, Lake levels is approx. 3 ½ feet below full and the water is currently 60 degrees.
- **Rim of the World Historical Society:** Duane Banner announced that the Museum Gift Store will be open November 14 & 15.
- **The Tudor House:** ... shared that they are still offering activities and events. The Speakeasy is currently located outside.

6.0 Unfinished Business: Short Term Rentals: Rindenow shared his thoughts on the upcoming Arrowhead Lake Association vote regarding lake use by short term rental customers.

8.0 Supervisor's Report: Lewis Murray discussed the results of the recent election. He also discussed the State's order regarding restaurants, churches, and other gatherings. He shared that the Board of Supervisors are working with the State with the goal of opening inside dining and other types of businesses in areas of the county with low Covid rates. He also announced that Cindy Gardner has been appointed to the Lake Arrowhead Dam Advisory Committee. The Supervisor is also looking for someone to fill the vacancy on the Rim of the World Recreation and Park District Board.
