5.0 Community & Government Updates: *This is an opportunity for Community Representatives & Government agencies to update the LAMAC on items of interest to the Lake Arrowhead Communities.*

- **Sheriff:** Captain Don Lupear, SBSB announced that the Twin Peaks station at full strength. They continue to provide HOV enforcement under contract with the USFS. Also utilizing the patrol to address homeless camps. Still prepared for fire conditions. The Board of Supervisors released funds for snow and traffic enforcement. Will begin extra patrols beginning December 1st. Be careful when shopping. Hide your valuables, purchases, and lock your cars. Lupear gave a thank you to the Alpine Mountaineer for a story regarding the need for citizen volunteers. They received several new applications. Lupear thanked Rick and Marlyn Dinon for the beautiful artwork she painted and donated. Lupear will be attending a meeting with other sheriff offices regarding parking signage in the mountains.

- **CHP:** Officer Griede shared that they had one retirement and one new Sergeant. Still collecting toys for Chips for Kids. Please donate toys for needy children. It is snow season, be prepared. You should carry chains, food water, blankets, and other emergency supplies. Slow down on icy/snowy roads.
- **Cal Fire:** Travis Lemm shared they are very busy. Still at full strength. Until significant rain will keep all stations open.
- **USFS:** Brian Grant shared some information related to winter operations and fire preparedness.
- **Lake Arrowhead Village:** Erin Wiley shared in writing an update on Lake Arrowhead Village. Not much going on due to Covid.
- **Lake Arrowhead Resort:** Julie Verduzco shared that there are a lot of changes at the hotel. New ownership, GM, and Chef. Right now, they are selling out on the weekends. Corporate groups are not occurring mid-week due to Covid restrictions.
- **Arrowhead Lake Association:** Bob Mattison discussed current lake conditions. The lake level is 5103.1 ft elevation and the temperature is 49.6 degrees.
- **Lake Arrowhead Chamber** Robin Bull said they are working hard to support local businesses. Restaurants are taking the hardest hit. Due to weather conditions, they had to revert back to pick up and to go food. Also, Geoff Hopper has volunteered to provide a free harassment seminar. Next GAC will be in January.
- **Rim of the World Historical Society:** Duane Banner shared that the sale went well in November. They have been closed all year. If you are interested in making a purchase call the number and leave a message.
