4.0 Special Presentation: San Bernardino County Office of Emergency Services

John Ferdon, Emergency Services Officer, County OES. Ferdon Discussed coordination of CERT teams in the mountains. He gave the history of CERT and how it evolved into what it is today. He played a video explaining what CERT is and does. He answered questions from the audience.

- California Highway Patrol: Sgt. Porter and Sgt. O'Brian shared they have several vacancies. Working closely with Cal Trans on Chain control. DUI activity has increased.
- Lake Arrowhead Village: Erin Wiley was not able to attend. Send a message via Vickie. Yes there will be a CVS in the near future. Should have the concert line-up for Lake Arrowhead Village later in March.

Council Member Ken Stowe

- SB County Fire: BC Tracey shared that March is wildfire preparedness. They have three OHVs. Will be using for rescue operations. Training to begin next month. Preparing boats and teams. County fire is working with their partners on homeless issues. Preparing for any sort of Corona virus issues in the County. Station 29 in Lake Gregory is completed and will be staffed when needed.
- Cal Fire: Travis Wiley stated that they are working on fuels projects across the mountain. Also participating in the Rim Fire Safe Council chipping program. For bug kill trees, contact Pilot Rock. One engine is stationed in Running Springs. Opening other stations on April 20th.

- Arrowhead Lake Association: Bob Mattison shared they are about 1 foot from capacity. Jr. Trout Rodeo on April 18th. The board has responded to the vote issue regarding Short Term Rentals using Lake facilities.
